### **PROF. MAURO GATTI**



After graduating cum laude in Economics at LUISS-Guido Carli, he obtained a PhD in Business Economics from the University of Catania, then, in 1998, he became a Researcher in Organization Studies at the University of Cassino.

In 2000 he was Associate Professor of Management at the University of Milan – Bicocca.

In 2002 he was Full Professor of Management at the University of Salerno.

Since 2008 he has held the position of Full Professor of Organization Studies at Sapienza University of Rome, where he currently teaches Organization (three-year degree) and Leadership and Organizational Change (master's degree in English).

For three years (2012-2015) he was the Director of the PhD in Management, Banking and Commodity Science, at the Department of Management of the Sapienza University of Rome.

In the initial part of his career he worked for the LUISS School of Management, where he held positions as tutor, coordinator of training programs and teacher.

From 2000 onwards, he has carried out numerous training activities for managers and executives of large and medium-sized Italian companies. He has worked as a management consultant for important Italian companies and has gained experience as a consultant in leading consultancy companies.

In the initial part of his career he was interested in the main topics of Business Economics, from Accounting to Financial Analysis, from Strategic Planning to Management Control, from Cost Analysis to Audit and Certification of Financial Statements.

Subsequently he gained specific skills in the field of Management, with particular regard to the issues of the systemic approach to Firm's Governance, Theory of the Firm, and Industrial and Commercial Techniques.

In recent years, in parallel with teaching Organization, he has developed his own research on various organizational topics and on the issue of Human Resource.
